tract for services now existing or heretofore made between the representative of any State or Territory and any attorney or agent;" now, therefore,

1. *Be it resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Legislature of the said State of Maryland hereby accepts the amount found to be due said State under the provisions of said act, and the trusts and conditions imposed in and by said act, in full satisfaction of all claims which said State of Maryland may have against the United States on account of the levy and collection of said tax.

2. *And be it further resolved,* That the Governor of the State of Maryland is hereby authorized to receive and receipt in full for said money in accordance with the foregoing resolution, and turn the same over to the treasury of the State of Maryland.

NO. 2.

Joint resolution requesting the Governor to issue a commission to the Honorable Arthur P. Gorman, Senator-elect from the State of Maryland, in the Congress of the United States.

1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That His Excellency the Governor of Maryland, be and he is hereby requested to issue a commission in the usual form to the Honorable Arthur P. Gorman as Senator-elect to represent this State in the Congress of the United States, for the term of six years, from the fourth day of March, eighteen hundred and ninety-three (1893).

Joint resolution authorizing the destruction of bonds known as the Treasury Relief Loan Bonds, held by the treasurer for the sinking funds and the transfer of stocks and bonds from the sinking fund known as the Treasury Relief Loan Sinking Fund, to the Defense Redemption Loan Sinking Fund.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the State, be and he is hereby authorized to destroy all bonds of the Treasury Relief Loan Fund, under chapter two hundred and thirty-eight of the acts of the
