Joint resolution requesting the Senators and Representatives in Congress from the State of Maryland to use all proper endeavors to have the authorities of the United States deed and convey to the State of Maryland the Naval Hospital Building located on the Government Farm adjoining the Naval Academy grounds near Annapolis.

Preamble

WHEREAS, the United States Naval Authorities have erected on the "Government Farm" adjoining the Naval Academy grounds at Annapolis a hospital building; which building has not been used for any purpose for a number of years, is consequently falling to decay; and

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland is desirous of acquiring Preamble a similar building for hospital purposes; therefore,

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Senators and Representatives in Congress from the State of Hospital Maryland, be, and they are hereby requested to use all Building proport offerto to have the United States outhorities great and proper efforts to have the United States authorities grant and convey to the State of Maryland, the Naval Hospital Building on the "Government Farm" adjoining the Naval Academy at Annapolis, with such quantity of land for the grounds necessary to the proper conveniences of such hospital.
