

TITLES OF LAWS.

No. 1. An act to authorize the Board of Police Commissioners of the city of Baltimore to increase the pension of James M. Moore, a retired patrolman of the police force of Baltimore City.	3
No. 2. An act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Montgomery county, to refund to Sarah A. Ellicott of said county, a certain sum of money for taxes erroneously paid to said county commissioners by her.	4
No. 3. An act to amend the certificate of incorporation or charter, of the American Casualty Insurance and Security Company of Baltimore City, as to the number and qualifications of the directors.	4
No. 4. An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section three of article twenty-one, of the Code of Public General Laws, title conveyancing as enacted by chapter two hundred and thirty-two of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and ninety.	5
No. 5. An act to repeal section two hundred and forty-nine, of article one of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Alleghany County," sub-title "Westernport," as amended by the act of 1890, chapter 135 and to re-enact the same with amendments.	5
No. 6. An act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of Messrs. Thomas and Evans, printers and publishers of Baltimore City, for printing the State schall report for the year of eighteen hundred and ninety.	6
No. 7. An act giving the leave and sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the acquisition of the leasehold interest in a lot of ground in the city of Baltimore by the trustees of the Washington street station of the Methodist Protestant Church in the city of Baltimore and State of Maryland, a body corporate of the State of Maryland.	7
No. 8. An act to repeal sections 157, 160, 163, 164, 166, and 174 of article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of
