No. 66. An act to enable "the Board of Trustees of Gaithersburg Methodist Episcopal Church, in the United States of America, of Montgomery County," a religious corporation, incorporated under the general corporation laws of the State of Maryland, to sell and dispose of certain real estate owned by it in Gaithersburg, in said county. 115

No. 67. An act to enlarge the powers of the County Commissioners of Talbot County so as to enable them to issue bonds of the county for an amount sufficient to raise a sum of money to take up and pay off the bonds of the county issued on account of the subscription by Talbot County to the capital stock of the Maryland and Delaware Railroad Company and maturing on the first day of April, eighteen hundred and ninety-two. 116

No. 68. An act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to certain bequests and devises contained in the last will and testament of Thomas S. Beall, late of Anne Arundel County, deceased. 117

No. 69. An act to amend the charter of the Kennard Novelty Company of Baltimore City, recorded October 30th, 1890, Liber 28, folio 351 of the charter records of Baltimore City. 118

No. 70. An act to authorize and empower the Governor to appoint an additional Justice of the Peace in election district number five in Frederick County. 118

No. 71. An act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of the Commissioners of Charities and Corrections for Frederick County for the support of five insane convicts at Montevue Hospital for the years 1890 and 1891. 119

No. 72. An act to incorporate the Tabb & Jenkins Hardware Company of Baltimore City. 119

No. 73. An act to provide for the trial by the Police Justice of the Peace of election district number two in Frederick County, of persons charged with violating any of the ordinances of the mayor and aldermen of Frederick, and to repeal section 183 and to repeal and re-enact with amendments, sections 238, 253 and 255 of article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Frederick County," sub-title "Frederick." 122

No. 74. An act to add an additional section to article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables," to be known as section 289 A, creating a Police Justice of the Peace for election district number two in Frederick County. 124

No. 75. An act to authorize and empower the Governor to appoint an additional justice of the peace in election district number twelve in Frederick County. 125
