

Senate bill entitled an Act to add to six additional sections to Article 6, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Caroline County," sub-title "County Treasurer," to follow section 68, to be called 68 A, 68 B, 68 C, 68 D, 68 E and 68 F.

Mr. Deen submitted the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out section 2, and add the following in lieu thereof:

"Section 2. And be it enacted that this Act shall take effect on the 1st Tuesday after the 1st Monday in November, 1893."

Which was rejected.
