

On motion of Mr. Laws,

Leave was granted to the Wicomico County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to authorize Sarah J. Holloway, of Wicomico county, to settle her accounts as guardian to Minnie F. Holloway, and to pay over all monies due said ward.

On motion of Mr. Green,

Leave was granted to the Somerset County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to tax dogs in Somerset county.

On motion of Mr. Fockler,

Leave was granted to the Washington County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Washington county to subscribe for an amount of stock in turnpike companies in said county.

On motion of Mr. Johnson,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Roads and Highways to introduce a bill entitled an Act authorizing the County Commissioners of Caroline county to build a bridge across Choptank River at or near Williston, in Caroline county, and to make a roadway to and from said bridge.

On motion of Mr. Garrott,

Leave was granted to the Washington County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal section 31, Article 22, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Birds and Game," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

On motion of Mr. Hamilton,

Leave was granted to the Baltimore County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal section 201, of chapter 49, of an Act passed at January Session, 1892, entitled an Act to repeal sections 182 to 217, inclusive, of Article 3, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore County," sub-title "Roads, &c.," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Temperance to introduce a bill entitled an Act to prohibit the
