

REPORTS OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

Mr. Schlaffer, from Select Committee, reported unfavorably,

House bill entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Towsontown, in Baltimore county.

Which was adopted.

Also, unfavorably,

House bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to levy a sum of money to build a fire engine house at the village of Highlandtown, Baltimore county.

Which was adopted.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to authorize, empower and require the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to appropriate a sum of money to pay the Registers of Voters of Baltimore county for transcribing the names of voters from the old registries to the duplicate registries, as required by chapter 573, of the Acts of 1890.

Which was read a first time.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to prevent the sale of fermented or spirituous liquors, or lager beer within a radius of one mile and a half from station of the Northern Central Railway at Monkton, in Baltimore county.

Which was read a first time.

Also, favorably, from Select Committee,

House bill entitled an Act to authorize and require the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to levy a sum of money to be applied to the building of a school house on the Philadelphia Road, in or near the village of Orangeville, in Baltimore county.

Which was read a first time.

Also, unfavorably, from Select Committee,

House bill entitled an Act to empower the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to build a new bridge across Back River, in said county, in place of the old Eastern Avenue Bridge, and to levy a sum of money for that purpose.
