House bill entitled an Act to enable Edgar W. McMaster, collector of State and county taxes for Worcester county, for the year 1886 and 1887, to enforce the payment of the taxes not heretofore collected by him.

House bill entitled an Act to aid, promote and encourage manufactures in the town of Easton, Talbot county, in this State, exempting them from county and municipal taxation.

House bill entitled an Act to enable and authorize the County Commissioners of Talbot county to subscribe to the capital stock of the Easton, Trappe and Cambridge Railroad Company.

Also, favorably, from Select Committee,

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Talbot county to build a road from the town of Oxford to Vanconver's Island, in said county.
