Also,

Joint Resolution authorizing the destruction of the bonds of the Exchange Loan of 1899, acquired by the exchange of the preferred stocks of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company, as authorized by Article 12, section 3, of the Constitution.

Which was read a first time and referred to Committee on Ways and Means.

Also,

Senate Joint Resolution authorizing the destruction of the bonds known as the "Treasury Relief Loan Bonds," held by the Treasury for the sinking funds and the transfer of stocks and bonds from the sinking fund known as the "Treasury Relief Loan Sinking Fund to the Defence Redemption Loan Sinking Fund."

Which was read a first time and referred to Committee on Ways and Means.

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 21, of Article 10, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Almshouse," and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add an additional section thereto.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Dorchester Delegation.
