House bill entitled an Act to amend Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Corporations," by adding thereto an additional section to follow section 20, class 7, and to be designated as "Section 20 A, Class 7 A," of said Article, providing for the formation of corporations for conducting any trading, commercial or mercantile business.

Was considered, and on motion, further consideration postponed, and made the order of the day for to-morrow at 1 P. M.

House bill entitled an Act to amend section 2, Article 3, and section 13, of chapter 495, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed January Session 1882, entitled an Act to incorporate the National Trust and Guarantee Company.
