

Mr. Carr submitted the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

On page 7, line 3, after the words "House of Refuge," strike out "three" and insert "five,"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Haines submitted the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

On page 3, line 2, strike out "forty" and insert "thirty."

Which was rejected.

Said bill, as amended, was then read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Berret submitted the following proposed amendments:
