

one new Commissioner every two years; and any person elected to the office of County Commissioner shall be ineligible for two successive terms. They shall each receive an annual salary of one thousand dollars, exclusive of mileage, payable monthly by the Treasurer of said county; and they are required to meet for the transaction of public business at their office at Towson on Tuesdays and Wednesdays of each week, and daily from the first Tuesday in March in each year, until the annual levy is made.
