Leave was granted to the Committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill entitled an Act to provide for an additional police sloop to protect the waters in St. Mary's county, St. Mary's River and Brittain's Bay.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Claims to introduce a bill entitled an Act to refund to Ross Compton, late Collector of Taxes for Garrett county, the sum of \$63.64, the amount overpaid into the Treasury of the State of Maryland, for taxes for the years 1888 and 1889.

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled an Act to prevent deception and fraud, by proclaiming, or publishing fraudulent or false pedigrees or records of stallions, and to protect such owners or agents in the collection of fees for services of such stallions, and to prevent the entering of trotting horses out of their classes.

Leave was granted to the Carroll County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 16, of Article 7, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Carroll County," sub-title "Circuit Court."
