Also, in section 20 G, line 177, after the word "Inspectors," add the words "by and with the consent of the Senate."

Also, after the word "Cambridge," section 20 G, line 181, add "one to Wicomico county and one for Somerset county, outside of Crisfield district."

Which were severally read and non-concurred in.

Also.

Joint Resolution authorizing the Comptroller of the Treasury Department to strike from the books of his office certain old and worthless accounts, and to discontinue the publication of the same in the annual report of the Comptroller of the Treasury.

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

House bill entitled an Act to amend chapter 284 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at its January Session of 1872, entitled an Act to incorporate the Baltimore, Hampden and Lake Roland Railroad Company.
