of an Act of Congress, approved August 30th, 1890, entitled an Act to apply a portion of the proceeds of the public lands to the more complete endowment and support of the colleges for the benefit of agriculture and the mechanic arts, established under the provisions of an Act of Congress, approved July 2nd, 1862.

Also favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to provide for the destruction of fruit trees in the State of Maryland inflicted with the disease known as the "Yellows."

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to chapter 374, of the Acts of 1890, entitled an Act to regulate the sale and the granting of licences for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in Baltimore county.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county to grant a pension to Greenberry T. Baxter, of said county.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize and direct the Sheriff. Justice of the Peace and other officers of Calvert county to pay over to the Treasurer for said county all moneys collected for fines, &c.

Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the Board of Police Commissioners for the City of Baltimore to increase the pension of James M. Moore, a retired patrolman of the police force of Baltimore.
