Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 26 and 27, of Article 65, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Militia," subtitle "Maryland National Guards."

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on Militia.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 8, of Article 19, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Comptroller," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Senate Joint Resolution authorizing the exhibition of relics in the possession of the State at the Bazar of the Society of Sons of the American Revolution.

Senate bill entitled an Act to amend Article 93, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to "Testamentary Law," sub title "Administration," by adding thereto an additional section to be designated "Section 32 A."
