House bill entitled an Act to sanction the bequest of John Young, of C., to the Evangelical Luthern Church of Frederick, of the residue of the testator's estate, to be applied to the Evangelical Lutheran Sunday School at Frederick city, Frederick county, Maryland.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to enable the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to appropriate a sum of money annually for the relief of the Simmons Home for Friendless Children of Baltimore.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 81, of Article 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," sub-title "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 4, of Article 33, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Elections," sub-title "Registration."

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors in School District No. 5, of Election District No. 9, of Worcester county.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 14, of Article 25, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," so far as the same relates to Talbot county, and to repeal section 31, of Article 21, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," sub-title "County Commissioners Compensation," and to re-enact the last named section with amendments so as to fix the terms and compensation of the County Commissioners of said county.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to protect associations and unions of workingmen and persons in their labels, trade marks and form of advertising, and to punish offenders for violation of the same.
