BILLS—SECOND READING.

House bill entitled an Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors within one mile of Holly Run Methodist Protestant Church, in the fifth collection district of Anne Arundel county.

House bill entitled an Act ceding to the United States of America the jurisdiction over certain property acquired by it for the use of the Government Hospital for the Insane, located in Prince George's county, Md.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 139, of Article 18, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county to furnish official badges to all police officers in said county.

House bill entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," sub title "State's Attorney," to follow immediately after section 434, and to be designated as "Section 434 A."

House bill entitled an Act to prohibit the use of any vessel in taking or catching crabs with scoop, scrape or dredge, in the waters of the Great Choptank river.
