House bill entitled an Act to permit the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to lay out and open public roads in the Nineteenth Election District of Baltimore county, within two miles of Baltimore city.

Said bill was then sent to the Senate.

Senate bill entitled an Act to establish a free bridge over the Patapsco River, between Baltimore and Howard counties, at a point near to Orange Grove, and to authorize the Commissioners of Baltimore county to levy a tax to the amount of \$15,000, and to authorize the Commissioners of Howard county to issue bonds to the amount of \$15,000, to be expended in the construction of said bridge and the acquisition of the necessary land adjoining it, and to authorize the condemnation of such lands, and to authorize the levying of taxes by the respective counties to provide for the payment of said bonds, with interest, and for the keeping of said bridge in repair, and to provide for the opening of roads to afford access to said bridge.
