

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

The Secretary of the Senate appeared and delivered the following message:

Senate bill entitled an Act to regulate the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer within three miles in every direction of the city of Cumberland, Maryland.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Allegany County Delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to add three additional new sections to Article 24, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Worcester County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to follow immediately after section 84, to be designated as "Sections 84 A, 84 B, and 84 C."

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Worcester County Delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act authorizing the Board of County Commissioners of Worcester county to appropriate the money now in their hands and such further sum as may be collected in the year 1892, from tongers licenses in said county, to erecting a canal, connecting the Synapuxent Bay with the Atlantic Ocean.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Worcester County Delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to protect fishing during the scraping season in the waters of Wye river, within the jurisdictional limits of Queen Anne's county, by prohibiting the taking or catching fish therein during the months of February and March.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Queen Anne's County Delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to regulate the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in St. Mary's county, and to regulate the issuing of license therefor.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the St. Mary's County Delegation and Mr. Lane.
