Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to sundry gifts, bequests and devises contained in the last will and testaments of certain persons, late of the State of Maryland, deceased, and also to certain gifts, grants, sales, leases and deeds made by various persons in this State, to and for the use and benefit of sundry ministerial persons, religious corporations, denominations or sects, and to certain charitable institutions hereinafter named.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Edmondson Avenue, Catonsville and Ellicott City Electric Railway Company.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the Judges of the Circuit Court for Baltimore county to purchase law books for the use of its public law library, and to provide for the payment of the cost of the same.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Baltimore County Delegation.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES.
