Also, strike out in line 5, section 1, "thirty-seven dollars and fifty-two cents," and add "thirty-four dollars and seventy-five cents."

Also, after the word "taxes," in line, 6, section 1, add "for years 1884, 1885, 1886 and 1887."

Which were severally read and concurred in.
