Leave was granted to the Allegany County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act supplemental to an Act passed at the January Session, 1890, of the General Assembly of Maryland, chapter 130, entitled "an Act to provide for the purchase or construction of water-works for the town of Frostburg, in Allegany county, and to authorize the Mayor and Councilmen of said town to issue bonds to pay the cost thereof" empowering the Mayor and Councilmen of said town to issue additional bonds to complete said water-works, and to amend said Act by abolishing the Frostburg Water Board, provided for therein.

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled an Act to add a section to Article 87, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Sheriff," sub-title "Oath of Office and Bond," to come in after section 4 of said Article, and to be called section 4 A, relating to the official oath to be taken by the Sheriff.
