

Senate bill entitled an Act to regulate the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer within three miles in every direction of the city of Cumberland, Maryland.

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

In section 1, line 7, after the word "direction," insert the following, "but not within said city."

Also, after the word "directions," at the end of line 44 of section C, insert as follows, "but not within said city."

Also, in line 54, section D, after the word "the," insert the following, "corporate limits of the."

Also, in line 96, section H, strike out all after the word "guests," down to the end of the section.

Also, in line 107, section I, strike out all after the word "thereof," to the end of said line 107.

Which were severally read and adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read a second time.

Which was read a second time.
