House bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of Eugene E. Grannan, Agent of the State of Maryland, appointed under authority of law to serve a requisition upon the Governor of Ohio in the case of State of Maryland vs. John Yeakle.

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendment."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In section 1, strike out the words "one hundred and seventy dollars and thirty cents," and insert in lieu thereof the words, "eighty-five dollars and fifteen cents, (\$85.15.)"
