

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations," sub-title "Insurance Department," to come in after section 121, and to be known as "Section 121 A," providing for the employment by the Insurance Commissioners of counsel for said department.
