Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 119 C, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations," sub-title "Insurance Companies," as amended by the Acts of 1890, chapter 254.

Mr. Carter, from the Committee on the Judiciary, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to add additional sections to Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Crimes and Punishments," to be entitled an Act providing for the safety of persons traveling on railroads, requiring railroads to operate telegraph or telephone service along their lines, to be designated sections 485, 486 and 487.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 139 to 141, inclusive, of Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Health, Hours of Labor of Children."

Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the Governor to sign, execute and acknowledge a deed conveying to the Canton Company of Baltimore any interest of the State in a lot in Canton, in the City of Baltimore, granted to the State for a hay scales on conditions.

Senate bill entitled an Act authorizing and directing the Attorney-General to furnish certain information in regard to the property purchased by the province of Maryland in 1755, and known as "Fort Frederick."
