Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 3, of Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Revenue and Taxes," sub-title "Valuation and Assessment," and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to repeal all Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent therewith.

Which was read a second time.

Also, favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore the assessments for benefits assessed on property of the State of Maryland, for the opening of Pulaski street, and for the benefits assessed on property owned by the State of Maryland, for the opening of Carrollton avenue.

Which was read a second time.

Also, favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the assignment and transfer of certain shares of the capital stocks of the Easton National Bank of Maryland, and of the National Mechanics' Bank of Baltimore, and of the Commercial and Farmers' National Bank of Baltimore, standing on the books of said banks in the name of the Orphans' Court of Caroline county, or the Judges thereof, to the Board of County School Commissioners of Caroline county.
