House bill entitled an Act for the better protection of game in St. Mary's county, to prevent the shooting or taking of same by non-residents without license.

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendments:"

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

In section 1, line 7, after the word "the," strike out "15th day of October," and insert "1st day of September."

Which, on motion, was non-concurred in.

Also,

Add to end of section 5 as follows:

"That nothing in this Act shall be construed to prohibit any land-owner or occupant thereof, from preventing any non-resident without license from killing any of said game upon their premises during the period allowed by this Act to residents of said county."

Which was concurred in.
