

Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the assignment and transfer of certain shares of the capital stocks of the Easton National Bank of Maryland, and of the National Mechanics' Bank of Baltimore, and of the Commercial and Farmers' National Bank of Baltimore, standing on the books of said banks in the name of the Orphans' Court, or the Judges thereof, of Caroline county, to the Board of County School Commissioners for Caroline county.

Was read a third time, and passed by yeas and nays, as follows:
