Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 112 and 113, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub title "County Commissioners," and to add two new sections thereto, to follow sections 112 A and 112 B.

Mr. Brashears submitted the following proposed amendments:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Strike out section 113.

Also, amend section 1, line 1, by striking out the words "and 113," and change the word "sections" to "section."

Also, in title, change "sections" to "section," and strike out the word "and 113."

Which were severally adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read a third time, and passed by yeas and nays, as follows:
