Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county to employ any and all male convicts and persons committed to the county jail of said county by the judgment of the Circuit Court of said county, or any Justice of the Peace thereof, in working the county public roads of said county and the streets of Centreville of said county, and to pass all necessary and needful rules and regulations in relation thereto.
