House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 127, of Article 22, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Fences," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Endorsed: "Reported unfavorably from Select Committee, and report adopted."

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendmerts section 94, of Article 12, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Garrett County," sub-title "Election Districts," and to add a new section thereto to come in after section 94, and to be known as "94 A."

Endorsed: "Reported unfavorably from Select Committee, and report adopted."

Also

House bill entitled an Act to prevent the sale of fermented, spirituous liquors or lager beer within a radius of one and a half miles from the point of crossing of the Baltimore and Yorktown Turnpike and the Northern Central Railway, at Parkton, in Baltimore county.

Endorsed: "Considered; vote by which amendments were adopted were reconsidered; amendments withdrawn; read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to regulate the price of illuminating gas in Annapolis city.

Endorsed: "Reported unfavorably from the Committee on Corporations, and report adopted."

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Courts," to be known as "Section 173."

Endorsed: "Reported favorably from Select Committee, rules suspended, and read the second time;
