

public or private sales by itinerant vendors, and to regulate such sales.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act granting the sanction and consent of the State of Maryland to the acquisition of certain lands within the said State by the United States, or by States or Historical Societies, for the purpose of erecting monuments and of properly marking the positions of different commands engaged in the battles of Antetiem and of the Monocacy, and for the preserving said battle fields for historical purposes.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the Board of Public Works to sell the Eastern Hay Scales property in the city of Baltimore, and to purchase a more eligible site in said city for the same.

House bill entitled an Act to regulate the taking of oysters in certain waters of the State.

House bill entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Baltimore, Canton and Point Breeze Railway Company, of Baltimore city.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 52, 53 and 54, of Article 5, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Calvert County," sub-title "County Commissioners."

House bill entitled an Act to amend section 3, of chapter 485, of the Acts of the Assembly of Maryland, 1882, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 136, of Article 37, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Gunning," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

House bill entitled an Act to add a section to Article 21, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Conveyancing," to be numbered 88.
