On motion of Mr. Carr,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Baltimore College of Dental Surgery.

On motion of Mr. Ellegood,

Leave was granted to the Wicomico County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to incorporate a company to be known as the "Dorman and Smyth Hardware Company of Wicomico County, Maryland."
