

Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the re-locating of a portion of Water street, in the city of Cumberland.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Allegany County Delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to refund to Emanuel Yeiser, late Collector of Taxes for the Third District of Carroll county, the sum of one hundred and nine 38-100 dollars paid erroneously into the Treasury of the State, in excess of the amount due by him for the years 1885, 1886, 1887, 1888 and 1889.

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 185, of Article 10, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Fish," as the same was repealed and re-enacted by the Act of 1890, chapter 516, and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add an additional section thereto to be designated section 185 B.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Dorchester County Delegation.

Also returned,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 122, of Article 4, of the Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Buildings," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
