the Hagerstown Manufacturing Mining and Land Improvement Company of Washington county, Maryland, a sum of money erroneously paid into the State Treasury for a "bonus" upon its capital stock for the year of eighteen hundred and ninety.

On motion of Mr. Sanders,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Labor to introduce a bill entitled an Act to authorize the Governor of the State to appoint a Board of Examining Engineers.

On motion of Mr. Miles,

Leave was granted to the Dorchester County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower trustees therein named to convey a lot of ground situated in New Market District, in Dorchester county, to the Board of County School Commissioners of said county.

On motion of Mr. Haines,

Leave was granted to the Carroll County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to regulate the compensation of officers of registration of voters in Carroll county.

On motion of Mr. Field,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled an Act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the acquisition, holding and disposing of a certain lot of ground in the City of Baltimore, on the southeast corner of George street and Clinton avenue, in Baltimore city, by the Perkins Square Baptist Church of Baltimore city.
