Baltimore," sub-titled "Streets, Bridges and High-ways," and to re enact the same with amendments.

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," to be known as "Section 806 A," providing for the payment of money into-Court under condemnation proceedings in certain cases.

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Courts," to be known as "Section 173 A," providing for the practice in certain cases in Baltimore City Court.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 44, of Article 14, of volume 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Howard County," sub-title "County Commissioners and Collectors," and to add four additional sections thereto, to be known and distinguished as "Sections 44 A, 44 B, 44 D and 44 E, respectively."

House bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claims of the Commissioners of Charities and Corrections for Frederick county.

House bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Wm. H. Ford, late collector of State taxes, in Kent county, overpaid by him into the State Treasurer.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 20 and 23, of Article 77, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled "Public Education," and to reenact the same.

House bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay J. H. Medairy & Co., for printing the official ballots of 1890 and 1891 November elections, as provided by sections 138 and 160, chapter 538, of the Acts of 1890, and also the registration books.

House bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of the Baltimore Publishing Company, printers and stationers of Baltimore city, for printing cards of insurctions to voters for the use of the State.

House bill entiled an Act to cede to the United.
