and they are hereby instructed to include in their assessment bill the taxation of mortgages.

Mr. Berret submitted the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out all after the word "hereby" and insert the following: "instructed to enquire into the expediency of the taxation of mortgages."

Mr. Brashears submitted the following proposed amendment to the proposed amendment:

Strike out all after the word "ordered."

Which motion prevailed.

Said order, as amended, was then adopted.

House bill entitled an Act to incorporate Elkton Electric Light and Power Company.
