

Mr. Haines, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 16, of Article 7, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Carroll County," sub-title "Circuit Court," providing for the drawing of jurors.

Mr. Leonard, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Commissioners of Easton to borrow a sum of money for the payment of certain debts due by said Commissioners, and to issue bonds for the payment of the same.

Which were severally read a first time.

Mr. Smith, of Washington county, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 161 and 162, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Washington County," sub-titled "Hagerston," amending and revising charter of said city, and adding additional sections to Article 22, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hagerstown."

Mr. Smith, of Washington county, moved a suspension of the rules in order to read a second time House bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 161 and 162, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Washington County, &c."
