Also,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 20 and 23, of Article 77, of the Code of Public Education, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by year and nays."

House bill entitled an Act to enlarge and extend the powers and franchises of the Glynden Permanent Building Association of Baltimore county.

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Chapter 6. An Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of Messrs. Thomas and Evans, printers and publishers of Baltimore city, for printing the State School Report for the year of eighteen hundred and ninety.

Chapter 9. An Act to authorize and empower George T. Melvin to construct a bridge over Weems' creek, in Anne Arundel county.

Chapter 11. An Act to provide for the appointment of two Notaries Public, to reside in Cockeysville, in the Eighth Election Discrict of Baltimore county.
