1888 and 1889, a sum of money for State taxes paid by him into the State Treasury erroneously.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

ORDER OF THE DAY.

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

And it is further ordered, That the State Printer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to fur nish each Board of County Commissioners of this State with 100 copies of said report, to be disposed of or circulated by them under the direction of the County Grangers and County Alliances of the several counties, and all expenses to be paid by the commissioners of said county.
