Leave was granted to the Committee on Temperance to introduce a bill entitled an Act to enable the qualified voters of Election District No. 13, in Frederick county, to determine by ballot whether spirituous or fermented liquors shall be sold in said district.

Leave was granted to the Frederick County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to add additional sections to Article 11. of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," sub-title, "Liquors and Intoxicating Drinks," to follow section 311, and to be known as "Sections 311 A, 311 B, 311 C, 311 D, 311 E, 311 F, 311 G and 311 H," relating to the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors and lager beer in said Frederick county, and imposing penalties for the violation of said sections.
