The following Acts of the General Assembly originating in the House of Delegates, were presented to the Governor for his approval this day at 10.30 o'clock, A. M.

Chapter 17. An Act to add two additional sections to Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Railroad Obstructing," to follow section 231, and to be known as sections 231 A and 231 B, respectively.

Chapter 20. An Act to repeal sections 343, 344, 345, 346, 347, 348, 349, 350, 351, 352, 353, 354, 355, 356, 357, 358, 359 and 360, of Article 8, of the Code of
