

3rd. In section 6, insert the word "and," between the words "physical and agricultural," and strike out the words "and industrial," and also the words, "various industries of the."

4th. Strike out "section 12," (already enacted by another bill.)

5th. Make section 13, to be numbered 12.

Which were severally read and adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
