House bill entitled an Act to repeal and to re-enact with amendments section 214, of Article 12, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Garrett County," sub-title "Sheep."

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 743, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Police," and to reenact the same with amendments.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 153, of Article 17, of the Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's County," sub-title "Hyattsville," and to reenact the same with amendments.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Burgess and Commissioners of Middletown, Frederick county, Maryland, to issue bonds for the purpose of constructing, operating and keeping in repair the water works for said town.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 16, of chapter 334, passed at January Session, 1890, entitled an Act to regulate the sale and granting of license for sale of spiriutous and fermented liquors in Baltimore county.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to appropriate a sum of money to pay for the use of a suitable building to be occupied by the Members of the Veteran Volunteer Firemen Association of Baltimore city.

House bill entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Aberdeen, Harford county.

House bill entitled an Act to amend Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled "Corporations," sub title "Turnpike, Plank Road and Passenger Railway Companies," by adding a new section thereto, to be known as section 236 A.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 230 and 231, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Courts," relating to court stenographers, and to re-enact the same with amendments.
