AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Section 3. And said company shall also have power from time to time to issue bonds in such amount or amounts as the directors thereof may deem expedient, and to secure the payment thereof by mortgage of all or any part of the property, rights and franchises of said company.

Sec. 6. Strike out "or that may be used for such purpose."
