#### REPORTS OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 1 to 27 inclusive, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Almshouse," and to enact the following in lieu thereof, giving the commissioners of the county exclusive management of said "Almshouse."
