Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 214 and 214 A, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Sheriff," as said respective sections appear in chapter 395 and 503, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1890, and to add a new section to said Article to follow immediately after section 214 A, to be designated as 214 B.
