AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In section 2, line 18, after the words "Hackett's Point," insert "Thomas' Point."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Bryan submitted the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 20 A, line 178, after word "officer," insert the following: "Of the Oyster Police Force, Oyster Measurer or Inspector."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Smith, of Dorchester, submitted the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In section 2 G, line 212, after the word "inspection," add, "who shall not be engaged in any branch of the oyster business."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Sams submitted the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Add to end of section 20 F the words:

"And no cargo of oysters or portion of cargo of oysters shall be discharged from any boat upon any wharf or any other place in the State to persons purchasing the same before six o'clock in the morning or after six o'clock in the evening of the same day."

Which was rejected.

Mr. Collins submitted the following proposed amendment:

In section 20 G, line 211, after the word "appoint," strike out "five," and insert "six."

Which was adopted.

Also, the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In section 20 G, line 216, after the word "Oxford," strike out the word "and," and insert the words "one to" and place a "comma" after Oxford.

Which was adopted.
